- Be willing and able to check email at least three times a week, and respond in a timely fashion

- Strive to get Red Angus junior members involved and enthused about NAJRAE activities and make personal connections with the NAJRAE members from diverse regions and walks of life
- Forego public uses of alcohol, tobacco and illegal substances at all times during any NAJRAE related event during your term of service, regardless of your age
- Avoid places or activities that in any way could raise questions as to one's moral character or conduct
- Serve as a member of a team, always maintaining a cooperative attitude
- Represent the NAJRAE, your fellow Board of Directors, and the Senior Board with the greatest level of excellence, professionalism, and enthusiasm
